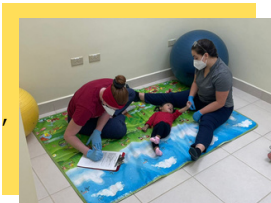

THERAPY SERVICE TRIPS

GUATEMALA



WHERE WE SERVE

We serve throughout Guatemala, touching the lives of thousands of people in need every year.

We maintain a primary focus in Zacapa, at our 17-acre Gualan Campus, and in Pueblo Modelo, where we have a learning center, daycare, gardening, and house construction programs. These two regions in Guatemala are experiencing the highest rate of need.



WHERE WILL WE STAY?

Groups of thirty people will stay in the HIM House in Teculután for the service portion of the trip. Larger groups will room at the Hotel Atlántico. Groups will always stay together at one location. Both locations have rooms with a bathroom, a pool, dining area for shared meals.



TRIP COST

We work directly with your group to determine the length of trip that works best for your group's goals. Typical trip lengths and costs are:

- 10-Day Mission Trip- \$1250 per person**
plus, a plane ticket
- 9-Day Mission Trip- \$1150 per person**
plus, a plane ticket
- 8-Day Trip- \$1050 per person**
plus, a plane ticket



WHAT'S INCLUDED?

The trip fee covers almost all expenses while on the trip, including:

- Meals and beverages while in Zacapa
- All dinners while in Antigua
- Lodging for the entire trip
- Ground transportation in Guatemala
- H.I.M. T-Shirt
- A personalized journal for your group
- Emergency Medical Insurance
- H.I.M. staff liaison dedicated to your group

Not included:

- Breakfast or lunch while in Antigua
- Souvenirs
- Meals in the airports while traveling



WHAT WILL YOU DO?

Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy groups work in various settings, providing evaluations and direct services to patients of all ages with disabilities. Therapy students and therapists work alongside Guatemalan therapists and students. Opportunities for continuing education for Guatemalan therapists.

- HIM and local therapy clinics
- Centers for disabled children
- Senior Centers
- Special Education schools
- Home Visits
- Mobile clinics in community settings
